## What Can We Do to Increase Equality?

(Suggestions from the congregation of the UU Church of Olinda at the third talk by Bobbye Baylis on Inequality, on May 12, 2013)

- 1. eliminate the Senate
- 2. focus on education early childhood ed
- 3. vote and carefully
- 4. remove financial impediment to U-level education (tuition)
- 5. make taxes more progressive and generally increase
- 6. remove tax loopholes (e.g., off-shore avoidance, capital gains reductions)
- 7. promote community
- 8. increase value-added jobs in Canada (e.g., not shipping raw resources to non-Canadian companies)
- 9. education about consequences of actions (and what actions are being taken)
- 10. support labour unions by regulations
- 11. counter overly simplistic proclamations
- 12. regain freedom of expression (as increasingly limited by lawyers, government)
- 13. still need personal responsibility (to afford fairness)
- 14. control of language (e.g. living off welfare vs. living off capitalism)
- 15. education about handling personal finances

## Added by Bobbye:

- 1. legislate a minimum annual income
- 2. increased transparency in government and business
- 3. increased openness in the media to presenting community-centric ideas as viable
