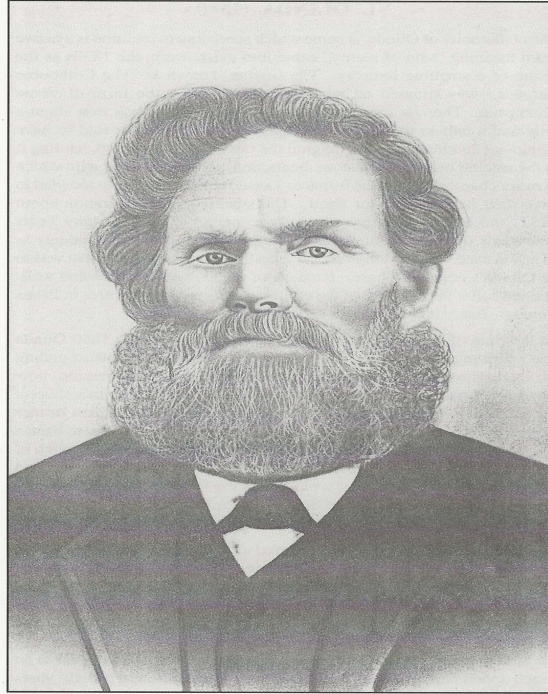

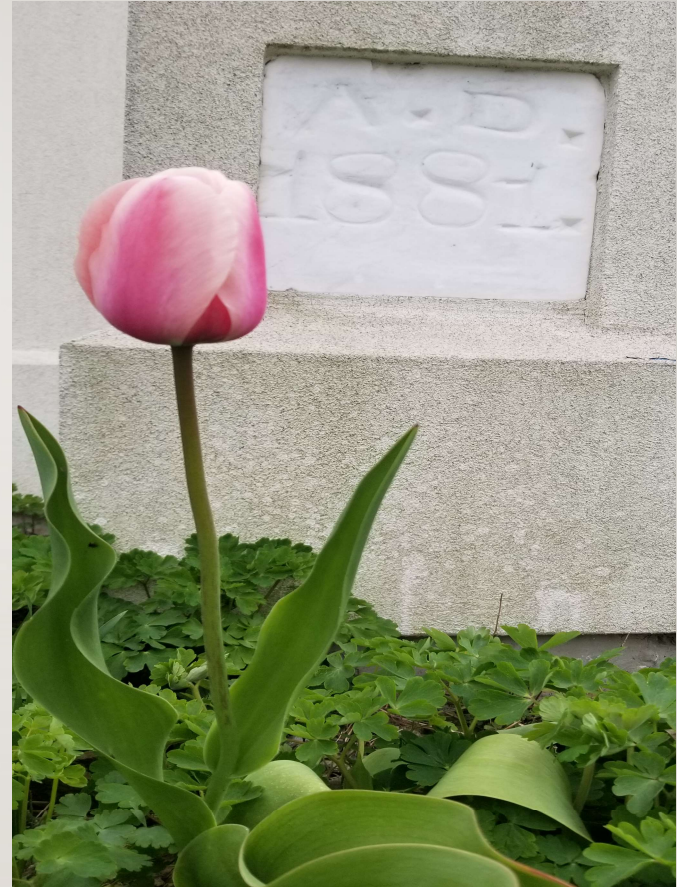


THE TIP OF POINT PELEE NATIONAL PARK

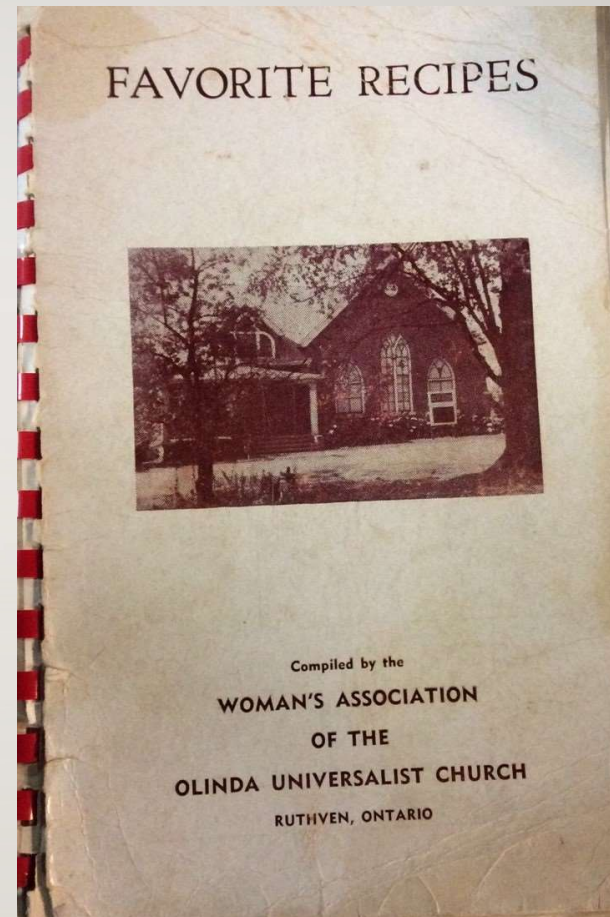

PIZZA PIE RECIPE FROM WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION COOKBOOK

Many time proven recipes were
included in this cookbook that were
congregational favourites

PIZZA PIE

1/3 c. warm water
1/2 tsp. sugar
1 pkg. yeast

2 c. flour
1 tsp. salt
2/3 c. warm milk
3 Tbsp. melted shortening or
vegetable oil

Dissolve 1/2 tsp. sugar in warm water, sprinkle yeast into water. Let stand 10 minutes. Mix flour, salt, warm milk with fork. Add yeast mixture. Mix well. Add melted shortening or oil. Knead until smooth. Cover and let stand 30 minutes. In the meantime mix the following:

3 c. canned tomatoes
1 tsp. sugar
2 cloves of garlic,
pressed or grated

1/2 tsp. oregano
1 can (12 oz.) of beef or
bologna (optional)
1 1/2 c. grated cheddar cheese

Divide dough in half. Roll out each half for 9 inch pie plate. Brush with oil or shortening. Prick pastry with fork all over. Fill with tomato and cheese mixture. Bake at 375 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes. Serve while warm.
